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Dear concert organizers,

We are delighted to be playing at your venue! So that everything runs smoothly and we all have a relaxed day together, we ask you to do the following things, which are listed here in the stage rider.

Travelparty

We usually travel with 6 people (5 band members, 1 photographer or management). We travel with two cars. A suitable parking lot near the venue would be desirable.

Backstage

A separate, quiet, lockable or guarded room that is available solely for the band with comfortable seating for at least 8 people would be desirable; ideally also a stable WiFi.

Catering

After a long drive, we are delighted to receive various chilled drinks on arrival, such as

Tea. coffee and snacks, as well as fresh fruit and snacks on arrival.

We would also like 4 vegetarian and 2 vegan meals.

If possible, please refrain from using Coca-Cola or Nestlé products in our catering. We do not like them so much

Towels and Stage water



Please have 24 x 0.5l bottles of still water in sealable plastic bottles and six white, pre-washed stage towels ready and hand them over to the tour manager

PA

Should be able to transmit loud rock music in the entire audience area according to the size of the event and the scale of the audience! Should be set up and calibrated at the Get In. Gladly seen: L-acoustics, d&b, Martin Audio Any volume limitation or limiter in the system must be agreed with us in good time in advance, but no later than four weeks before the event, otherwise we cannot guarantee this.



A stable, professional, balanced and braced stage of approx. 8x6m with a height of at least 1m is required. If possible, also a drum riser 3x2m with a height of 20 - 40cm.

Sound

We don't travel with our own sound engineer at the moment.

Monitoring

We bring our own in-ear rack with an X32 mixer and operate it ourselves, so no other technician is needed for monitoring. Please make sure that any other IEM transmitters are switched off so that there is no interference. **Important:** We use the rack of a band friend who uses more channels, so the numbering of the rack and our patch plan is not quite identical. Channels 1-20 are identical, after that it differs, the additional numbering in the table helps, it shows the numbers that can be read on the rack and the cable whip.

Lights

We are currently traveling without our own lighting technician.


